

Certified Scrum Product Owner Agreement

Congratulations! By completing the Certified Scrum Product Owner course and signing this Agreement we (the Scrum Alliance, Inc.) officially designate you as a Certified Scrum Product Owner.

As a Certified Scrum Product Owner, you get the following benefits:

- a. The right to use the “Certified Scrum Product Owner” and “CSPO” titles and the current version of the Certified Scrum Product Owner logo. Your permitted use of these items is described on the Scrum Alliance website at www.scrumalliance.org.
- b. A one year membership in the Scrum Alliance, with all the current benefits as described on the Scrum Alliance website.
- c. You will be listed as a Certified Scrum Product Owner on the Scrum Alliance website.

Your certification does not currently have an expiration date. If that changes, notification will be posted in a public area of the Scrum Alliance website. Under no circumstances will your certification expire within one year of being granted.

Becoming a Certified Scrum Product Owner makes you eligible to become a “Member” of the Scrum Alliance. Your initial certification includes a one-year membership in the Scrum Alliance, after which you may renew your membership annually by paying the current membership dues (currently USD\$50). You will continue to be a Certified Scrum Product Owner for the remainder of your certification term even if you do not remain a Member of the Scrum Alliance after this initial one-year period.

If we believe you have not adhered to this Agreement or the Scrum Alliance membership obligations (as posted on the Scrum Alliance website), we will notify you in writing and expect you to correct the issue within thirty calendar-days. If you do not comply within that time, this Agreement will terminate and you must immediately stop representing yourself as a Certified Scrum Product Owner. We may decide not to enforce our rights in one situation but still enforce them for an identical or any other future situation.

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Colorado and is the final, complete and exclusive agreement between you and us with respect to your Certified Scrum Product Owner certification.
